Annette Lagunas, Acting Executive Director with the Humane Society of Yuma, stated that this her first opportunity to personally address the City Council and she wanted to thank them for their support. City staff have been very helpful to her over the last several weeks. She just received the \$7,900 check from the City for the feral cat spay/neuter program. She looks forward to working with each and every member of the City Council. Wilkinson commented that it has been a pleasure working with Annette. The City is building a good working relationship with the Humane Society.

Phil Clark, 4296 W. County 15th Street, recalled that on March 20, 2013 at the Regular City Council Meeting, the City Council discussed the Riverfront development. At that time, staff could not answer all of his questions, but said the information would be forthcoming. On May 15, 2013, he again requested the information and, later still, he reminded the City Council that he had yet to receive the requested information. He reiterated that he has requested: 1) the checks paying the 1% surcharge. He assumed there was only one check, but was told that because of changing accounting systems, there were multiple checks. He filed a Request for Public Records for the one check number, and has received that one check. However, it was indicated at the March 20, 2013 City Council Meeting that payments were made every quarter, and those other checks have yet to be received. 2) Information on the Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment Account (FFE). FFE funds can be used only in the hotel for refurbishing of the hotel and hotel rooms. 3) Written consent of the lender for the amended lease just prior to the foreclosure sale. He recalled that Deputy Mayor McClendon and Mayor Krieger directed staff to get him the information.

Wilkinson displayed a list of 371 public record requests by Clark and a copy of the check he has received with its receipt. All of the checks are available in the Clerk's Office; Clark can pick them up at his convenience.

Clark objected, asking where the other information is and saying he will be in the Clerk's Office tomorrow for everything he's asked for.

IX. EXECUTIVE SESSION/ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, Mayor Krieger adjourned the meeting at 6:16 p.m. No Executive Session was held.
